Save Money While You Sing...in the Shower

- and to help prevent water shortages in our area.
1. Install a recirculating hot water system. Do you turn on the hot water to shower in the morning, but have to wait for the water to turn warm? Well, a recirculating hot water system will reduce the amount of time you have to wait for that water to heat up. These systems are so efficient at reducing water consumption that nearly all hotels use them.
 2. Install water saving faucets and aerators. New water saving faucets can reduce the water flow from our standard water

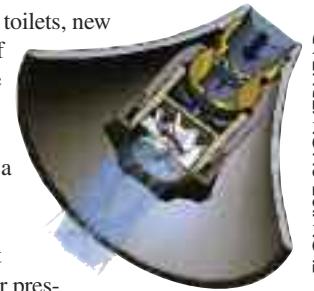
Within the next five years it's estimated that over thirty states will experience water shortages, and the shortages are likely to expand to more states as water becomes scarcer and the climate continues to change. There are a number of things we can do to conserve our household use of water

faucets by 30%. This may not seem like a lot, but remember that this will also reduce the amount of water consumed by your hot water heater.

3. Install a high-efficiency toilet. In America, nearly 100 million toilets flush with 3.5 gallons per flush. New toilets flush with only 1.3 gallons per flush. These new toilets can save up to 16,500 gallons of water in a year for a household. That's a huge savings if your water comes from a well.

4. Install a pressure-reducing valve in the main water line. As with high-efficiency toilets, new showerheads can save a lot of water. New showerheads use at least 30% less water than standard showerheads and they do it without sacrificing a strong flow of water.
5. Install a high performance showerhead. Ask the folks at A-Comfort to check the water pressure on your main water line. Your water pressure may be too high and needlessly wasting water and shortening the life of your water pipes.

FALL CHECKLIST

- **Get your mind in the gutters.** Inspect and clean gutters and down spouts.
- **Button up your overcoat.** Seal gaps and cracks around windows and doors with weather-stripping and caulk.
- **Get on top of roof problems.** Inspect your roof for damaged or curled shingles, corroded flashing, or leaky vents.
- **Walk the walks (and drives).** Take steps to repair damaged sidewalks, driveways, and steps.
- **Chill out.** Drain and winterize outdoor faucets and irrigation systems.
- **Freshen your filter.** Clean or replace dirty furnace filters.
- **Give your furnace a physical.** Have a professional inspect your heating system.
- **Gather round the hearth.** Check fireplaces for soot or creosote build-up.
- **Keep the humidifier humming.** Clean the plates or pads to ensure efficient operation.
- **Keep the wood fires burning brightly.** Wood stoves are making a comeback. To avoid a deadly situation, be sure to inspect yours before firing it up.
- **Keep your family safe at home.** A home safety check should be an annual ritual in every household. Test smoke and CO detectors, inspect (or install) fire extinguishers, review fire escape plans, and rid your home of old newspapers and other fire hazards.
- **Upgrade!** Get rid of your old, inefficient furnace and replace it with a new high efficiency unit. Look for the Energy Star label when purchasing.
- **Hot Water Heater:** Have a professional drain your hot water heater so they can remove sediment from the bottom of the tank.
- **Drip-Drop....** Check for leaky faucets in kitchen and bathroom.
- **Attic:** Close vents to conserve heat.
- **Fireplace:** Clean fireplace of ashes. Check chimney for loose or missing mortar. Have chimney professionally cleaned. Make sure damper closes tightly.
- **Refrigerator:** Make sure your refrigerator door seals are airtight. Test them by closing the door over a dollar bill. If you can pull the bill out easily, the latch may need to be adjusted or the seal may need to be replaced. In addition, if you have a coil-back refrigerator, vacuum the coils at least twice each year. Your refrigerator will run more efficiently with clean coils. Also, stock up! A full refrigerator uses less energy than an empty one.
